



Coldwater Rally Weekend July 26-27, 2014 Supplementary Regs

Type of Event:

The Coldwater Rally Weekend is a weekend of Rally Activities consisting of Meetings, Co Driver Schools, Steward Training and a Test Day.

Weekend Activity Overview:

Friday

Rally Pacific Motorsport Annual General Meeting

The meeting will be held in the Coldwater Ranch Lodge-please RSVP to Nicki to ensure enough copies of documentation are made.

Saturday

Cod River Rally-Sprint - Coldwater Stages: \$70/person (includes Pace Note Fundamentals)

Based on the successful Cod River Rally co-driver school, this half-day co-driver fundamentals school will teach co-drivers everything they need to know to get through an performance rally event successfully. The class will cover pre-event preparation, paperwork and team planning, route books and schedules, planning for recce and writing pace notes, Various timing systems and time cards, being effective in the rally car, driver management and motivation.

*While the half-day course doesn't have any practical exercises, the Coldwater Test Day Weekend will have several opportunities to put what you've learned into practice.
(3 Hours)*

Pace Note Fundamentals: \$20/person

*This is a short theory course that will provide a foundation for writing good, reliable pace notes and is aimed at drivers who have little or no experience writing their own notes. Experienced teams that would like to improve in writing reliably good notes can probably learn from this course as well. The class will cover the function of pace notes, the language of pace notes, different systems, understanding what is important, preparation for recce, how to make the most of two-pass recce,
(1 hour)*

Steward Training

For experienced members of the rally community who would like to explore being a steward for TSD and stage events, this all day training session will be taught by Tom Burgess on protocol, requirements for CARS, and expectations of Stewards. Recce

Recce will be offered on Saturday evening, as well as Sunday morning; There will be no limits on the number of passes or the make-up of teams participating in the recce. i.e. Any registered participant can recce with any other registered participant. Multiple passes will be allowed.

Sunday

Test Day: \$225 per car

Coldwater Rally Weekend is a test day and training. The test day will be run following the rules of the CARS National Rally Sprint Regulations (Part C, Section 2). Unofficial timing may be available, but scoring will not be provided.

Jurisdiction:

The West Coast Rally Association (WCRA) is the organizing club and the entire event will be sanctioned by CARS and insured by ASN Canada FIA. Coldwater Rally Test Day is a non-competitive event but will be run under the CARS Rally Sprint Rules.

Eligibility:

All drivers/co-drivers will be required to hold a \$10/day, or \$25/year Rally Pacific Motorsport Basic Licence if they do not hold a CARS national or regional performance competition licence while follow Rally Sprint Regulations outlined in 28.2.2.1 – Competitors. Competition vehicles must follow the Regulations in 28.2.2.2 – Vehicles, and 28.2.2.3 – Mandatory Equipment. As competition vehicles will be on private property for the entire event, current insurance is not required. Licenses will not be sold at the event.

Service:

The service area will be in a field on the Coldwater Ranch property, please take what garbage you produce and ensure that tarps are used to catch any debris from the vehicles being serviced. Fuelling will be at the participant's discretion and teams are responsible for cleaning up their own spills. Teams are required to bring spill absorbents with them as well as fire extinguishers if they plan on refuelling.

Emergency Services:

No official emergency services will be on site, however first aid trained personnel will be on site. There will also be no sweep vehicle running behind the competition cars, but extraction will be available during the lunch break, after the runs have finished for the day, and as needed to keep the stage safe to run.

Communications:

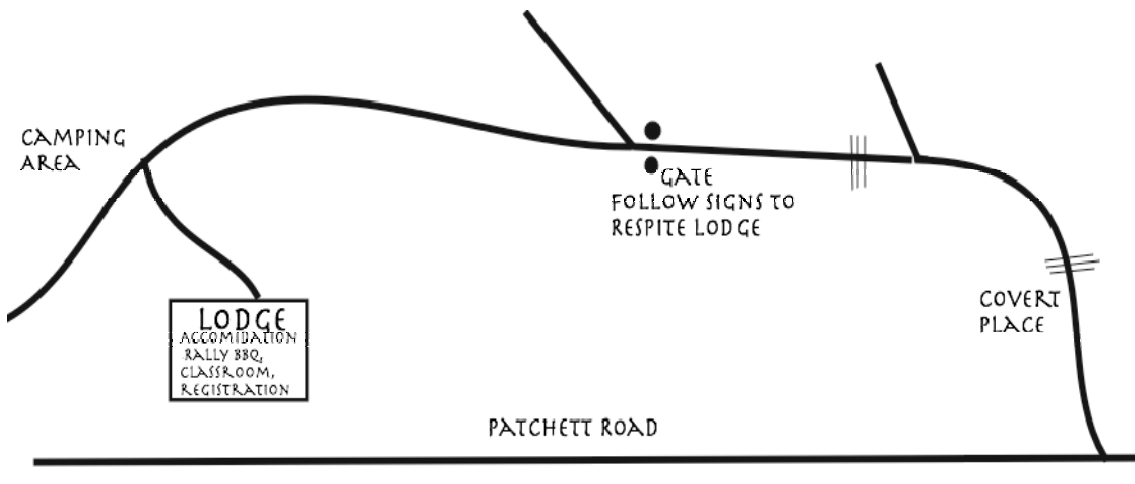
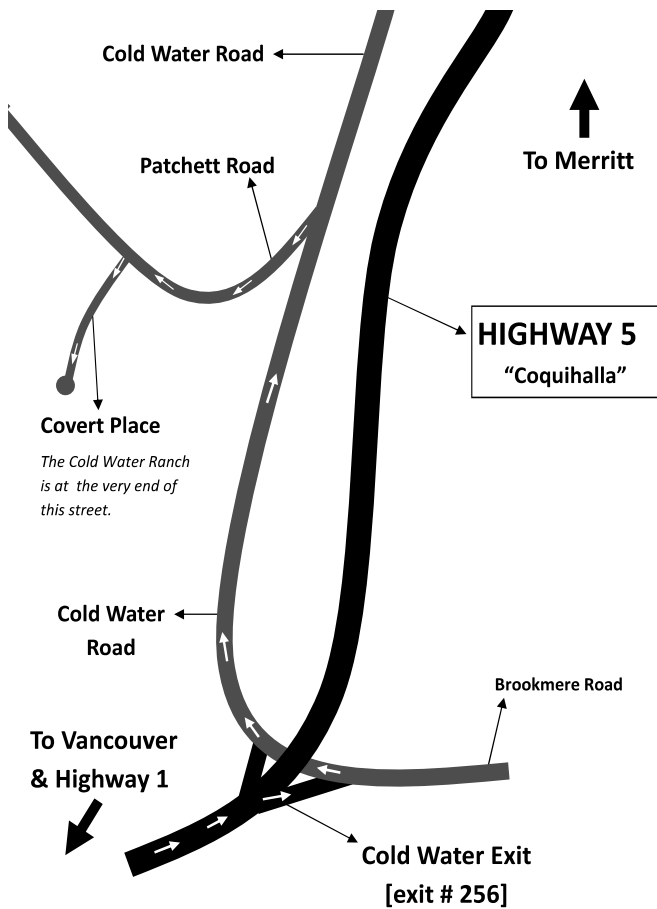
Cell coverage on the Coldwater Ranch is pretty good, however official communications will be conducted on the HAM radio network on a simplex frequency. Secondary communications will be via FRS radios. Competition cars are strongly advised to carry a HAM radio or a FRS radio to contact rally officials while on course if needed.

Personal Safety Equipment/Waivers:

A Head and Neck Restraint meeting CARS requirements, or equivalent, is strongly recommended by the organizers. Please refer to the CARS National Sprint Regulations for further details on all personal safety equipment. All persons on the ranch property will be required to sign a waiver and wear a wristband. All minors must also have their guardians or parents sign a minor waiver form.

Venue:

The Coldwater Rally will be hosted at the Coldwater Ranch, just outside of Merritt BC. All camping, servicing and Rally Sprint course will be on Coldwater Ranch property, with permission of the owners of the Coldwater Ranch property and the Abilitas Foundation.



Camping/ Accommodation:

Note: 100% of accommodation fees will be donated to the Abilitas Foundation.

Camping will be available for \$15.00 per night. A kitchen with refrigerator, as well as bathrooms and shower facilities will be available at the lodge, which is approx. a 150m walk from the camping area.

Shared Lodge accommodations for 10 guests is available for \$25 per night per person on a first come-first served basis.
